



Colleton Medical Center has a new PET/CT program every other Thursday. This allows Colleton Medical Center to provide vital information for cancer patients in Colleton County and the surrounding area.

PET/CT is a powerful combination of two diagnostic tools in one scan. It combines Positron Emission Technology, which shows how organs and tissues are functioning at a cellular level, offering insight into their metabolic activity, with Computed Tomography (CT), which provides detailed images of internal anatomy and the location of structures in your body.

When used together, PET/CT can create a complete picture and help physicians pinpoint abnormalities. PET/CT is a very important tool for Oncologists and Radiation Oncologists as they plan the treatment for their patients.
